


YEAR IN NUMBERS

In 2022, we are proud to have contributed \$112,000 to 23 partners in a non-operational capacity.

In 2022. Hi2 Foundation reached thousands of individuals across the continents through contributions towards scholarship opportunities such as the Greater China Scholars Program at Notre Dame University, towards higher education and professional development channels such as the Columbia China Forum at Columbia Business School, and towards cultural advancement programs such as the Huaxia Chinese School.

ASIAN CULTURE PARTNER HIGHLIGHT: **HUAXIA CHINESE SCHOOL**



School (HXCS) is dedicated to teaching Mandarin and Chinese culture classes. The largest of its kind in the United States, the school consists of 22 branches, serving over 7,000 students in New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, and Connecticut.

In 2022, Hi2 Foundation supported Huaxia Chinese School and its branches to provide a variety of activities for students to develop a comprehensive sense of Chinese culture, including the Milburn Lunar New Year Festival, Huaxia New York Central Chinese School, Huaxia Cup Painting Contest, and Huaxia Chinese School 2022 Graduation Ceremony.



PARTNER HIGHLIGHT: THE GREATER CHINA SCHOLARS (GCS) PROGRAM



The Greater China Scholars (GCS) Program, the University of Notre Dame's premiere merit Scholars Program for international undergraduate students, was created with the recognition of the critical importance of encouraging exceptional students from around the world to attend Notre Dame. The program not only aims to attract the region's brightest, but also students with great capacity for global leadership and commitment to the betterment of society.

In addition to merit-based scholarships, the Program also provides Scholars with a full range of enrichment and mentorship programming to enhance their spiritual, intellectual, and leadership capacities throughout their undergraduate studies at Notre Dame.
